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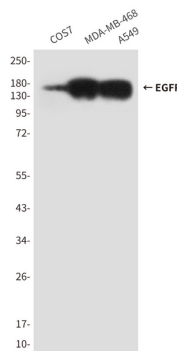
Background

EGFR is a receptor tyrosine kinase. Receptor for epidermal growth factor (EGF) and related growth factors including TGF- α , amphiregulin, betacellulin, heparin-binding EGF-like growth factor, GP30 and vaccinia virus growth factor. Is involved in the control of cell growth and differentiation. . A single-pass transmembrane tyrosine kinase. Ligand binding to this receptor results in receptor dimerization, autophosphorylation (in trans), activation of various downstream signaling molecules and lysosomal degradation.

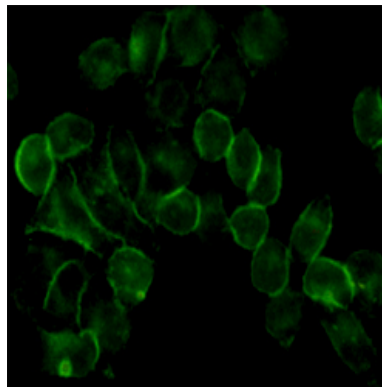

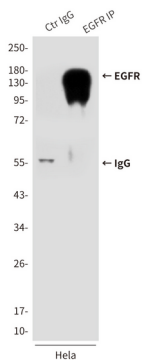


Western blot analysis of EGFR in A549, MDA-MB-468 and COS7 lysates using EGFR antibody.

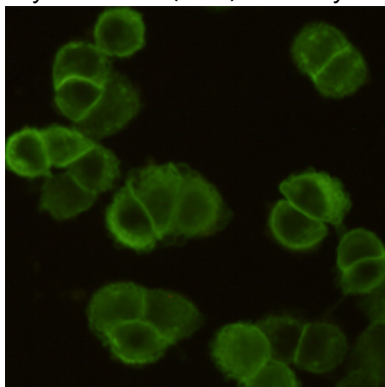


Immunocytochemistry analysis of EGFR (5E10) in HeLa using EGFR antibody.
