Background

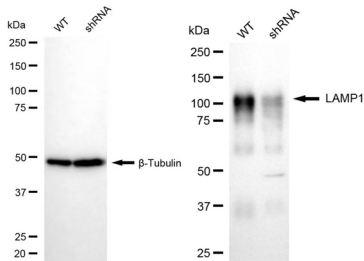
The protein encoded by this gene is a member of a family of membrane glycoproteins. This glycoprotein provides selectins with

carbohydrate ligands. It may also play a role in tumor cell metastasis. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]

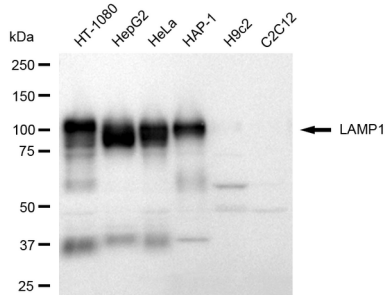

Western blotting analysis using LAMP1 antibody (KVA00828). LAMP1 expression in wild type (WT) and LAMP1 shRNA knockdown (KD) HT-1080 cells with 30 μ g of total cell lysates. β -Tubulin serves as a loading control. The blot was incubated with LAMP1 antibody (KVA00828, 1:5,000) and HRP-conjugated goat anti-rabbit secondary antibody (APS0635, 1:10,000) respectively.



Western blotting analysis using LAMP1 antibody (KVA00828). Total cell lysates (30 μ g) from various cell lines were loaded and separated by SDS-PAGE. The blot was incubated with LAMP1 antibody (KVA00828, 1:5,000) and HRP-conjugated goat anti-rabbit secondary antibody (APS0635, 1:10,000) respectively.
